CONFERENCE AND PROCEEDINGS OVERVIEW

The 3rd IoT Security Foundation Conference is a one-day event and follows on from the 2016 'Building an Internet of Trust' Conference at IET Savoy Place, 2015's IoTSF Conference held at the Royal Society and the original IoT Security Summit at Bletchley Park.

Knowing It's Safe To Connect

A founding value of IoTSF is "security first". This speaks to the fact that good security has to be considered from the beginning of the lifecycle and, along with our third value "resilience", maintained throughout. Much of the work carried out by IoTSF to date has deliberately prioritised the vendor side of the equation for the simple reason that if security capabilities are not provided from the start, fit-for-purpose security is challenged.

Yet, what about the user side of the equation? Does the IoT market understand the implication of insecurity to their business? Do purchasers know what good security looks like or how to ask for it? Are there good examples of how security should be done? This is the next phase of our work – *taking security expertise into the application domain*.

The 2017 IoTSF Annual Conference will bring vendors and users together with security experts, researchers and key stakeholders to discuss security "in the round". Attendees will learn how companies are providing security capabilities and how users are implementing them. This will be framed by a wider outlook of the contemporary issues and take a look into the future with a view from the research agenda.

An accompanying table-top exhibition complements the conference track and the day ends with a drinks reception allowing extra time to discuss the themes of the day and additional networking.

The conference will have a senior and expert level line up of speakers which are announced as part of the promotional activity and can be found on the conference website.

VENUE



Savoy Place is a unique London venue situated by the River Thames. It has recently been re-opened following a £30 million pound refurbishment offering increased capacity and easy access by rail, tube and river!

The conference takes place in the Kelvin Lecture Theatre which has a capacity exceeding 450 delegates and technical workshop sessions with capacity for 70 delegates.

History

Savoy Place has a rich history dating back to 1889

- Completed in 1889, Savoy Place was designed by Stephen Salter and H Percy Adams as a joint examination hall for the Royal College of Physicians and Royal College of Surgeons
- On 1 June 1909, The Institution of Electrical Engineers (IEE) bought the lease of the building and refurbished it to suit the needs of its members
- In 2006 the Institution changed its name to become the Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET) and Savoy Place.
